

**RULES AND REGULATIONS AGREEMENT  
WORLD WAR II WEEKEND  
GRAEME PARK  
SEPTEMBER 24-25 2011**

- Weapons inspection will be performed before each skirmish.
- A designated PHMC safety officer will be present at all inspections.
- Edged weapons are not to be drawn at any time during the skirmish.
- Hand to hand combat is not permitted.
- No member of the public will be allowed to handle any weapons.
- Each unit will safely secure all ammunition.
- All ammunition will be checked by the designated safety officer by 9:30AM on Saturday and Sunday morning.
- Passes issued at ammunition check will be inspected at weapons check.
- Said passes must be carried on your person at all times.
- Campfires will be allowed on Saturday evening and ground must be returned to its original condition at the conclusion of the event.
- One water bucket filled with water must be kept at the fire.
- Alcoholic beverages are not permitted on park grounds.
- Weapons demonstrations for the public must be approved by the safety officer.
