Their narratives feature accounts of freedom seekers who were often pursued by slave catchers, incidents of kidnapping, & extraordinary acts of bravery undertaken by those committed to securing their freedom. Central to these efforts was the Progressive Friends Meeting, located just outside Longwood Gardens, which brought together influential figures such as Sojourner Truth, Frederick Douglass, Harriet Tubman, & others.
